**The Difference Between
A Catholic Versus A True Christian**

Catholic (False Christian):
Preoccupied with Mary, Popes, Cardinals, Priests, Monks, Nuns, Altar Boys, Sacraments, "The Mass", Mass Cards, Novenas, Last Rites, First Holy Communion Ceremonies, Confirmation Ceremonies, God Parent Designations, Religious Costumes, Monstrances, Eucharists, Shrines, Statues, Cathedrals, Penance, Purgatory, Lent, Stations Of The Cross, Rosaries, Scapulars, Sacred Hearts, Confession Booths, Miraculous Medals, Crucifix Jewelry, Crucifix Statues and The Catechism...

True Christian:
