
Protestant Martyrs And The Bloody Inquisitions Of The Catholic Church

Martyrs Mirror also known as The Bloody Theater, was first published in Holland in the year 1660 by Thieleman J. van Braght. This massive book documents the tragic stories of Christians martyred (or murdered) by the Catholic Church, although that was done indirectly at times by the secular authorities under the control of the Vatican.
