

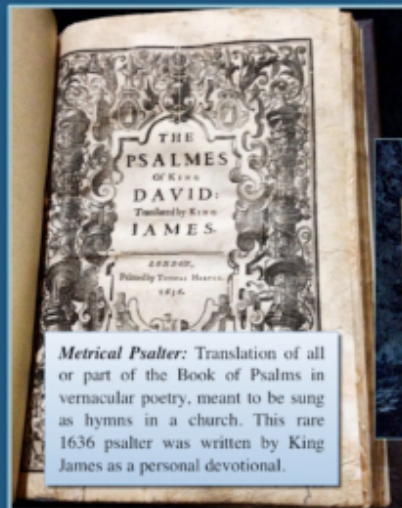

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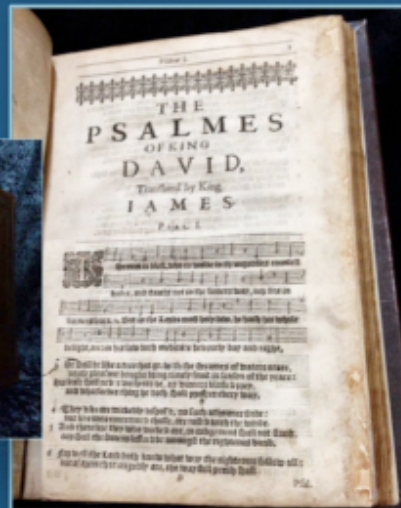


The Psalmes Of David

Metrical Psalter: Translation of all or part of the Book of Psalms in vernacular poetry, meant to be sung as hymns in a church. This rare 1636 psalter was written by King James as a personal devotional.

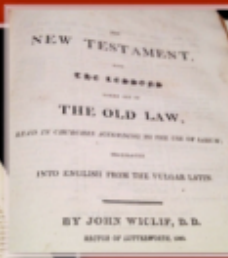


William Tyndale's 1549 "Matthew's" Bible



Matthew's Bible was the combined work of three individuals working from numerous sources in at least five different languages. The entire New Testament (first published in 1526) was revised, 1534 and 1535; the Pentateuch, Jonah and in David Daniell's view, the Books of Joshua, Judges, Ruth, First and Second Samuel, First and Second Kings, First and Second Chronicles, were the work of William Tyndale. Tyndale worked directly from the Hebrew and Greek, occasionally consulting the Vulgate and Erasmus' Greek New Testament. The complete Bible for the preface, marginal notes and the biblical text. The use of the pseudonym "Thomas Matthew", resulted possibly from the need to protect Tyndale from the authorities of Tyndale in the translation. The remaining books of the Old Testament and the Apocrypha were the work of Miles Coverdale. Coverdale himself was a student of Tyndale and is credited to the exclusion of the other. In reality they knew each other and occasionally worked together. Foxe states that they were in London translating the Pentateuch together as early as 1529. (SOURCE: wikipedia.org)

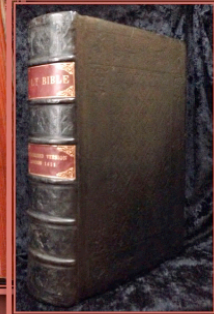
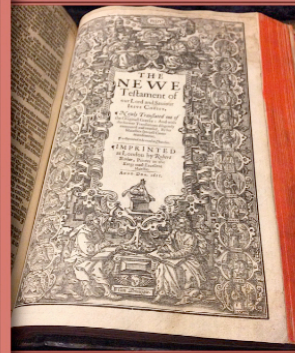


Wycliffe was an early advocate for translation of the Bible into the common language. He completed his translation directly from the Vulgate into vernacular English in the year 1382, now known as Wycliffe's Bible. It is probable that he personally translated the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John; and it is possible he translated the entire New Testament, while his associates translated the Old Testament. Wycliffe's Bible appears to have been completed by 1384, with additional updated versions being done by Wycliffe's assistant John Purvey and others in 1388 and 1395. [SOURCE: wikipedia.org]

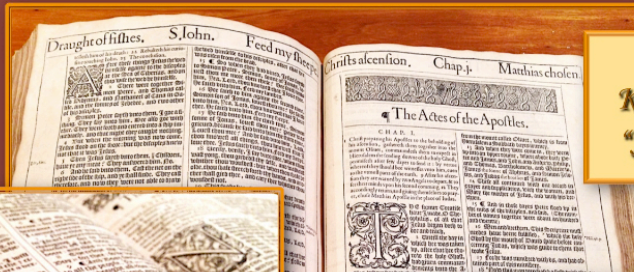
