You must believe in Him His way, not your way: "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven." [Matthew 7:21]. What is God's will - it is for us to be holy: "Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy." [1 Peter 1:16]

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Can a person be unholy and still end up in heaven? Most people want to go to heaven someday. After all, who really wants to go to hell? But the Bible tells us heaven is a place of absolute moral purity and holiness, where no sin can be allowed. So why would an unholy person ever want to go to heaven? Surely they would be miserable there without the ability to indulge in the kinds of activities that they were engrossed in here on earth. Why would they want to live with the author of the Bible after having continually violated His commandments all their lives? The truth is, such people will never go to heaven. Jesus Christ is Lord of heaven. If He does not become Lord of your life on earth, do not expect Him to welcome you with open arms into heaven...

"And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him." [Luke 12:4-5]

If God has not made you holy yet by converting you to Christ, I urge you to earnestly read your Bible and seek the Lord today!
